Those living in the area feel more aligned to the Highcliffe area and its village/holiday amenities including its shopping facilities. Mudeford and Stanpit should be included into the creation of a Christchurch Town Council. This area has many historical connections with the Priory Town and should not be separated. Therefore the inclusion of Friars Cliff into a Walkford and Highcliffe Parish/Neighbourhood should be one of only two new parishes in the Borough not three.
