



## Local Authorities (Executive Arrangements) (Meetings and Access to Information) (England) Regulations 2012

### Statutory Notice under Regulation 10: Key Decisions taken in cases of General Exception

Pursuant to Regulation 10 of the Local Authorities (Executive Arrangements) (Meetings and Access to Information) (England) Regulations 2012 ('the Regulations'), Notice is hereby given that-

The decision maker shown below intends to make a Key Decision on behalf of BCP Council about the matters detailed in the table.

This decision is urgent and cannot reasonably be deferred. Consequently, it has not been possible to give 28 clear days' notice of the intention to make the Key Decision, as required by Regulation 9 of the Regulations.

As required by Regulation 10 of the Regulations, the Chairman of the relevant Overview and Scrutiny Committee has been informed of the matter about which the Key Decision is to be made by being given the above Notice.

<b>Subject:</b>	Update on Establishing a Multi Disciplinary Team and a Homeless Health Centre
<b>Purpose:</b>	<p>In May 2021, Cabinet approved the further development of a Multi-Disciplinary Team (MDT) to better address the health needs of individuals who are homeless.</p> <p>Cabinet also approved the acquisition of St Stephens Church Hall, Bournemouth, to be used as a Homeless Inclusion Health Centre ('Health Hub') within an approved budget.</p> <p>Programme governance has been established for this work, the MDT is developing well with various partners engaged, and conveyancing and the required due diligence continues in relation to the acquisition of St Stephens Church Hall.</p> <p>Options are set out in the confidential Appendix A for the acquisition, refurbishment and management of the building which could bring additional investment requirements for the Council and therefore need further due consideration.</p>
