Statutory Notice under Regulation 10: Key Decisions taken in cases of General Exception

Pursuant to Regulation 10 of the Local Authorities (Executive Arrangements) (Meetings and Access to Information) (England) Regulations 2012 ('the Regulations'), Notice is hereby given that-

The Cabinet intends to make a Key Decision on behalf of BCP Council about the following matter.
