

Local Plan spending priorities for Strategic CIL

The table below combines the spending priorities identified through the following local plans:

- Bournemouth Core Strategy (2012)
- Christchurch and East Dorset Core Strategy (2014)
- Poole Local Plan (2018)

These priorities were listed in what were known as Regulation 123 Lists. Regulation 123 of the Community Infrastructure Levy Regulations (2010) (as amended) was deleted in 2019. Despite this, these priorities remain the latest agreed position covering the BCP Council area and remain relevant in supporting the growth planned through the local plans. A new list will be drawn up to support the emerging BCP Local Plan.
