WE PROPOSE TO ADD CONDITIONS THAT WE MUST OPERATE IN LINE WITH AN AGREED DISPERSAL POLICY AND NOISE MANAGEMENT PLAN. BY DOING SO THIS CREATES FLEXIBILITY SO THAT WE CAN ADAPT OUR OPERATION TO MEET ANY CHANGES REQUIRED BY RESPONSIBLE AUTHORITIES WITHOUT THE NEED FOR FURTHER VARIATIONS OR CONDITIONS.

a) General – all four licensing objectives (b, c, d and e) (please read guidance note 11)

WE ARE COMMITTED TO ENSURING THAT THE PREMISES ACTIVELY PROMOTES THE FOUR LICENSING OBJECTIVES. THIS IS REFLECTIVE IN OUR POLICIES WHERE WE HAVE FULLY CONSIDERED HOW OUR PREMISES WILL IMPACT ON THE LICENSING OBJECTIVES AND WHAT MEASURES WE WILL PUT IN PLACE TO MITIGATE RISKS. WE CONSIDER IT ESSENTIAL TO MAINTAIN A POSITIVE AND ENGAGING RELATIONSHIP WITH RESPONSIBLE AUTHORITIES, LOCAL BUSINESSES AND LOCAL RESIDENTS SO THAT OUR PREMISES PROVIDES BENEFIT TO THE COMMUNITY.

b) The prevention of crime and disorder

THE PREMISES WILL PRIMARILY OPERATE AS A RESTAURANT WHERE WE DO NOT ANTICIPATE ANY SIGNIFICANT ISSUES GIVING RISE TO CRIME AND DISORDER. THE MAJORITY OF ISSUES ARE LIKELY TO ARISE AFTER 2100 AND SPECIFICALLY ON FRIDAY AND SATURDAY WHERE WE WILL EXPECT HIGHER DEMAND FOR COCKTAILS. WE HAVE CONSIDERED THE RISKS AND SET OUT WHAT WE CONSIDER TO BE APPROPRIATE PLANS TO MINIMISE CRIME AND DISORDER IN OUR DISPERSAL POLICY. THIS INCLUDES DOOR SUPERVISORS, 100% ID POLICY AT PEAK TIMES, ENGAGEMENT WITH OTHER VENUES AND ACTIVE PARTICIPATION IN THE PUBWATCH SCHEME. OUR DISPERSAL POLICY WILL BE A WORKING DOCUMENT WHICH WILL BE SUBJECT TO REGULAR REVIEW AND CONSULTATION WITH RESPONSIBLE AUTHORITIES. CCTV WILL BE IN POSITIONED INSIDE THE PREMISES AND THE FRONT FACING IN BOTH DIRECTIONS OF CHURCH STREET.

c) Public safety

ALL SAFETY MATTERS WILL BE ADEQUATELY COVERED BY THE HEALTH AND SAFETY AT WORK ACT ANDTHE REGULATORY REFORM (FIRE SAFETY) ORDER 2005. ALL OF OUR STAFF AND CONTRACTORS WILL ACTIVELY MONITOR ALCOHOL CONSUMPTION AND HAVE DELEGATED AUTHORITY TO REFUSE TO SERVE ALCOHOL TO THOSE WHO ARE INTOXICATED OR AT RISK OF BECOMING INTOXICATED. WE WILL CONDUCT ROUTINE CHECKS OF CUSTOMERS ON ARRIVAL AND THROUGHOUT THE EVENING TO DETER AND MINIMISE THE RISK OF DRUGS AND WEAPONS BEING BROUGHT INTO THE PREMISES. WE WILL CONDUCT ROUTINE CHECKS OF THE TOILET AREA, INCLUDING DRUG SWABS OF FLAT SURFACES. WE WILL ACTIVELY PROMOTE 'ASK ANGELA', AND HAVE LEAFLETS AVAILABLE TO CUSTOMERS FOR TURNING POINT AND DRINK AWARE. WE WILL IMPOSE A 100% ID POLICY ON FRIDAY AND SATURDAY NIGHTS FROM 2100, AND WE WILL ENFORCE CHALLENGE 25 AT ALL TIMES AT THE BAR.

d) The prevention of public nuisance

WE WILL OPERATE IN LINE WITH THE NOISE MANAGEMENT PLAN AS APPROVED BY THE LOCAL AUTHORITY. THIS PLAN SETS OUT WHAT STEPS WE WILL TAKE TO REDUCE THE RISK OF PUBLIC NUISANCE INSIDE AND OUTSIDE THE PREMISES. THIS PLAN WILL BE SUBJECT TO REGULAR REVIEW BY THE PREMISES AND THE LOCAL AUTHORITY, SPECIFICALLY ENVIRONMENTAL HEALTH. ANY ALCOHOL SOLD FROM THE PREMISES FOR USE OFF THE PREMISES, WILL BE MARKED IN SUCH A WAY THAT IT CAN BE IDENTIFIED AS BEING SOLD BY TIKI BAR LTD.
