## Background

- 1. On Friday 28<sup>th</sup> January 2022, Mr David Lane on behalf of BCP taxi private hire association emailed the Licensing Manager with a request for a change to the current fares and charges which are published in the form of Tariff charts. This request is attached at Appendix 1
- The current tariff was agreed by the Licensing Committee on 4<sup>th</sup> March 2020, shortly after this meeting Covid 19 lockdown occurred and the trade asked for the implementation of the increase to be delayed. The agreed increase was implemented as of 1<sup>st</sup> May 2021. (see Appendix 2)
- 3. Mr Lane has been invited by the Chair to present the reasons for this request during the meeting.

## Consultation

- 4. Section 65 (2 a and b) of the Local Government (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1976 require that when any change is made to the fares and charges for hackney carriages, the council must publish a notice of the amended charges in at least one local newspaper and must specify the period of not less than 14 days, for objections to be made.
- 5. A copy of the notice must also be published at the council offices for the period of 14 days from the date of first publication.
- 6. If no objections are received the change will come into operation on the date of expiration of the notice.
- 7. If objections are made and not withdrawn, then the committee will have to consider the objections and any agreed changes or modifications would then come into operation on a specific date no more than 2 months after the original consultation period.

#### **Options Appraisal**

Members consider the request for an adjustment in the current fares and charges. The current rate of inflation is 5.5% with the Bank of England predicting it could rise to 7% during the year.

For information to compare our fares with other areas the Private Hire and Taxi Monthly magazine publishes a fare chart. You can search by local authority. <u>Hackney Taxi Fare</u> <u>Tables (phtm.co.uk)</u> The proposed increase will change the fare from £7:20 to £7:80.

Members can either

- I. Approve the changes as requested. The proposed chart reflecting the changes as requested is attached at Appendix 3.
- II. Approve the changes with amendments as agreed by members, a new fare chart will then be created.
- III. Refuse the proposed change and retain the current fare tariff.
