

Cruxton Vale Park
This will be a major new open space for the existing and new
residents of Merley and Cakley. It will provide an attractive
approach from Cakley Lane down to the riverside.

(i) New Cale Park
This will be a memorable new park at the heart of the Cruxton
Mead identity area on the route of the Principal Tree Lined

03 <u>Stags Head Oak Park.</u> Another neighbourhood park focused on an existing mature Oak Tree.

Cruxton Farm
A separate proposal will bring forward employment space on the farm site. The scheme will safeguard access into the employment.

(03) Ass interface The Ass eage will be focused on mitigating the impact of noise from the road on the scheme.

Tree lined principal street

The tree lined principal street will be a unifying feature which binds the core parts of the scheme and underpins the street

(i) Landmark building.
This prominent corner will be visible from a number of points from inside and outside the site.

<u>Neighbourhood Play Area (NEAP)</u> This key facility will provide play opportunities for new and existing residents.

Stour Glade
Linear woodland will provide an attractive setting to the
housing and filter views of the site from the other side of the
valley at Colehill.

(10) <u>Cakley Lane Street Trees</u>
New street trees will be planted along the full length of Cakley Lane.

11 SUBS
New balancing ponds will be designed in a manner which maximises their role in providing usable public space and provides a softer rural edge.

(3) <u>Green gateway (Two Cabs Green</u>.

An attractive gateway into the eastern part of the scheme will be achieved by establishing a strong vista toward the mature trees in the morth. Natural Play Areas define the space.

(3) Protesting the Carriage Drive for the future Parkland will run alongside the Carriage Drive creating a green setting to this part of the scheme. A secondary avenue of trees will be planted to safeguard the future of the Carriage

(4) Canford Magna Interface
Car free frontages and new parkland to create a bespoke interface with the Conservation Area.

(3) Wider Strategic Open Space
The proposed footpath network will seamlessly link wider strategic open spaces along the Stour Valley.

(6) Productive Landscape
The interface between Cructon Farm will be defined by allotheents and an orchard with 8 parking spaces. This area also provides a buffer to the Cructon Mead Area.

(1) SANG
The proposed footpath network will seamlessly link wider strategy open spaces along the Stour Valley.

(8) Care Home

Fronts onto the main open space and is within walking distance of Oakity shops. It will be an important gateway and landmark building with a landscape buffer next to the CA.

19 <u>SANG car park</u> A car park comprising 12 spaces will be provided to facilitate access to the adjacent SANG.

(20) Cruxton Farm interface.
This area has been carefully designed to present a softer edge to the Cruxton Farm area and Oakley Lane Conservation Area.

Dorset terraces
The terraced forms in these areas will take their one from the traditional terraces found in Dorset villages.

22 COMMUNITY CAT PAVE
This car park will be for the use of community activities in the Canford Magna area.

Locally Equipped Area Playspace (LEAP)
 This play facility will be an important resource for new and existing residents.
