# Application to Vary Premises Licence – Supplementary Information to support Representation

## Conroys, 33 Sea Road, Boscombe, Bournemouth

This report is to be considered alongside the formal Representation submitted in respect of the Application to Vary the above Premises Licence submitted to the Licensing Authority. It is the intention of Dorset Police to avoid any repeat of information previously submitted and to provide both the licensee (or their representative) and members of the Licensing Sub-Committee with additional information, context and evidence in support of the application. This report is being completed and submitted as soon as practicable for the benefit of all parties. Whilst all details are correct at the time of completion, Dorset Police reserve the right to amend / introduce additional information and evidence in advance of the hearing.

#### **Background**

The Premises Licence for 33 Sea Road was last updated on the 17<sup>th</sup> February 2021, providing for a 'Fish & Seafood Restaurant and Take Away'. The location of this premises is within an area of Bournemouth known for high levels of anti-social behaviour and conditions were agreed to ensure that the premises retained its character as a Restaurant, which are considered to be far lower risk that alcohol-led licensed premises.

Most crucially, a condition requiring that alcohol is served ancillary food at all times ensured that the responsible authorities and local residents could be reassured that the premises would only be used as a restaurant.

More recently, there have been complaints and concerns raised by local residents in respect of this premises and two visits to the premises by Officers from Dorset Police have led to concerns that existing Licence Conditions are not being met.

Two Warning Letters have recently been submitted to the Premises Licence Holder by Dorset Police and this premises remains of concern to Dorset Police due to a lack of general compliance and upholding of the licensing objectives.

The premises is located in a residential area and adjacent to a school for vulnerable adults. It is imperative that licensed premises add value to the community and do not adversely affect those that already enjoy use of that area.

#### Concerns

Dorset Police are concerned that the extension of hours, when considered alongside reports of unlicensed regulated entertainment (including DJ's), and a lack of food availability, is indicative of the new premises management re-purposing the premises to be a general entertainment space with music rather than a restaurant, which is what had previously been agreed.



Whilst the applicant has been clear that they are not requesting the removal of Condition 2.6 on this occasion, Dorset Police suspect that the applicant intends to make a 'phased' approach to converting this Restaurant by extending the hours of licensable activity and introducing regulated entertainment to this premises in the first instance before seeking the removal of condition 2.6 at a later time.

Dorset Police are concerned that the introduction of additional alcohol provision and regulated entertainment will further compound the issues currently identified as being of concern, alongside the reports from the public since the application was submitted.

Specific examples of the concerns identified are as follows -

9<sup>th</sup> April 2022 – Officers attended the premises and observed that customers were seen to be consuming alcoholic products without food. Officers were informed that the premises do not serve food beyond 6pm each day.

12<sup>th</sup> April 2022 – Follow up visit conducted by Dorset Police and despite advice being offered 3 days prior, alcohol continued to be served without food, contrary to condition 2.6 of the existing licence which was intended to reflect the primary intention for the business.

21st April 2022 – Confrontation between a drunk customer of Conroys and a member of the public who was obstructed from leaving the area in their vehicle. This individual was extremely concerned by the behaviour and that it occurred during late afternoon. The informant did not wish to make a formal representation due to fears of retribution as they may be recognised in the area.

Dorset Police are of the view that it would be inappropriate to extend the use of this premises beyond its initially intended use without careful consideration of the concerns that have been raised. Additionally, the existing conditions attached to this licence proportionately reflect those of a restaurant in a Town Centre location and are not considered appropriate to a premises operating either in to the early hours of the morning or indeed as an 'alcohol-led' premises with entertainment, which attracts very different risks.

#### **Available Outcomes to the Sub-Committee**

To assist the members of the Sub-Committee, Dorset Police make the following submissions in relation to the available outcome options in respect of this Application to Vary an Existing Licence -

#### **Application Granted**

Dorset Police are of the view that granting the licence as applied for would present a significant risk of undermining the licensing objectives.

The current operators have demonstrated inability to adhere to the existing conditions of the licence. Coupled with complaints from local residents regarding activity which is inconsistent with the operating schedule of the premises licence, there is a strong likelihood that the operator will fail to promote the licensing objectives if the Sub-Committee were to extend the existing provision further.

#### **Application Granted subject to Conditions**

Due to the concerns that Dorset Police have in respect of this premises, Dorset Police are of the view that to allow the additional licensable activities will likely undermine the licensing objectives.

If the Sub-Committee were inclined to grant the additional activities, Dorset Police consider that there would be such a departure of the existing operating schedule (restaurant) that there would be a requirement for a complete review of the existing conditions.

The existing conditions were intended to reflect a restaurant in a Town Centre and this notable change would require consideration of further conditions to include, but not limited to, the provision of SIA staff when licensable activities were taking place beyond 9pm.

However, Dorset Police do not have confidence that the applicant will be able to meet any new conditions based on their recent performance.

#### Licensable Activities listed in the Application Excluded

Dorset Police are committed to ensuring that licensed premises are both fit for the purpose intended by the applicant and operate to the benefit of the community.

This premises licence was intended to be a Restaurant and whilst the Licensing Act 2003 does permit the variation of any premises licence, doing so must not risk undermining the licensing objectives.

The application relates to the extension of the operating hours and the addition of late night entertainment, both of which conflict with the original intention for the premises. This is, in effect, a significant departure from the purpose of the licence and whilst the extension of the opening hours of the premises as a 'Restaurant' may be considered acceptable, Dorset Police are of the view that the addition of late-night entertainment demonstrates that the premises no longer intends to be a Restaurant.

#### **Reject Application**

Dorset Police understand that the applicant had failed to understand the conditions of the licence when purchasing the lease for this premises. The applicant failed to appreciate that this premises was intended to be a Restaurant with a schedule of conditions to suit that purpose.

Dorset Police are of the view that any departure from this purpose should be permitted with caution. It is clear from the concerns raised by local residents that incidents have already been occurring at this premises which have been to the detriment of the local area, most likely in breach of existing conditions.

It is the view of Dorset Police that this application should be rejected for the applicant to demonstrate over a period that they can consistently operate within the existing licence conditions, before they should be permitted to extend the licensable activities further.

#### Conclusion

Matters of fiscal interest are not of concern to this Sub-Committee. The applicant has undertaken a premise with proportionately restrictive conditions given its proximity to dwellings and a school for vulnerable adults.

This licence was deliberately intended to reflect that of a restaurant and any departure from that primary purpose should be done so with caution and in conjunction with a complete overhaul of the conditions, including the removal and addition of conditions which provide the responsible authorities and other interested parties with the confidence that the licensable activities will be delivered in promotion of the licensing objectives.

Dorset Police have detailed above concerns, identified during the two most recent visits to the premises, which demonstrates that the operators either do not have the necessary competence to deliver the provision in accordance with the conditions of the licence or have deliberately failed to meet the conditions of the licence.

Whilst it is the default position to grant a variation, the Sub-Committee members must do so only when there are no genuine concerns raised by the Responsible Authorities or residents. In this matter there are concerns. Given the severity of these concerns, coupled with the risk of further disorder and nuisance to the community, the Sub-Committee are invited to reject this application and to allow the Responsibilities further opportunity to seek improvement at this premises before any additional licensable activities are granted.
