Good Afternoon,

In respect of the attached application for a Premises Licence, on behalf of the Chief Officer of Dorset Police I object to this application for a Premises Licence on the grounds that to grant this licence will likely undermine the licensing objective the prevent crime and disorder.

The applicant, whilst having clear intentions to deliver a safe and compliant event, has failed to apply sufficient enforceable conditions to the licence to enable Dorset Police to have the confidence that the event will meet certain minimum requirements. Whilst many of these requirements may be detailed within the Final Event Management Plan, much of that plan remains in draft form and it is our view that many areas, whilst they may be elaborated on further within the EMP, should also be formalised and included as conditions within the Premises Licence.

It is our intention to engage in mediation with the applicant to agree suitable conditions in advance of any hearing. I will ensure that I keep you updated of any progress during this period.

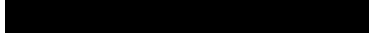

Hello,

With regard to the above application and on behalf Environmental Health I would like to raise an objection to the application on the grounds that it does not sufficiently support the licensing objective of the prevention of public nuisance.

The conditions offered in the operating schedule are not sufficient or specific enough to reassure me that the annual event could be held without the likelihood of public nuisance being caused.

Discussions have been held with the applicant and improvements have been made to their Noise Management Plan however we would need further discussions and improvements to their licence conditions prior to the hearing in order for Environmental Health to be in a position to withdraw this representation.
