

# APPENDIX 5

"Dear Licensing Authority,

As neighbours to the new bar that is due to be opened by KW Trading Limited, we wish to object to the application for a premises license. We are concerned over the noise from the bar and the impact on surrounding residents, especially those with children. The bar and our flats are positioned in buildings from the 1930s they were not built to soundproof this type of noise.

We are also concerned over the issues with crime, disorder and public nuisance from patrons who become drunk and disorderly the police are very slow at responding. It is very likely that patrons will vacate the Fiveways at closing time and then go here to continue the night. When First and Last Sip were in the same property, patrons would hang around continuing drinking and smoking on walls near the bar and causing a public nuisance.
