In respect of this application, I can advise the street drinking and associated ASB is a priority for Bournemouth East Neighbourhood Police Team, and that this application for a late night off licence would compound these problems, thereby resulting in greater demand for police and other resources. As such, I am in the process of mediating proportionate and meaningful conditions to ensure that the Licensing Objectives of the Prevention of Crime and Disorder, and Public Safety, are promoted by restricting the ABV of beers/ciders/lagers, in addition to crime prevention measures to include a member of staff on the premises at all times it is open for licensable activity who is able to access CCTV.

This condition is needed in order to safeguard both staff and customers in this late night environment.
