Re: Cost of SEND Services to BCP Council ((Bournemouth, Christchurch and Poole)

Please find attached, a letter which I have today sent to the Secretary of State for Education, but which identifies a major challenge to the ongoing financial viability of BCP Council, so needs your support.

In summary, we have identified an existential challenge as we will run out of cash to fund our services early in the next financial year, according to our forecasts, due to the cash outflow on the SEND budget where the cost of providing the statutory services greatly outstrips the budget provided by DfE.

Despite our best efforts, and participation in the Delivering Better Value and the Safety Valve programmes, DfE and their advisors have been unable to find a resolution to our challenge. Early in the next financial year, we will not have enough cash to fund our services, which is an untenable position for us to reach as a council.

I would be grateful for your urgent attention to this matter and your support for our financial position.
