

LOCAL GOVERNMENT AND PUBLIC INVOLVEMENT IN HEALTH ACT 2007

Bournemouth, Christchurch and Poole Council (Reorganisation of Community Governance) (Bournemouth) (Supplementary) Order 2026

Made - - - - 31 March 2026

Coming into force in accordance with article 1(2)

BOURNEMOUTH, CHRISTCHURCH AND POOLE COUNCIL (“the council”), in accordance with section 82 of the Local Government and Public Involvement in Health Act 2007 (“the 2007 Act”), has undertaken a community governance review and made recommendations dated 14 October 2025.

The Council has decided to give effect to those recommendations and, in accordance with section 93 of the 2007 Act, made the Bournemouth, Christchurch and Poole Council (Reorganisation of Community Governance) (Bournemouth) Order 2025 dated 23 December 2025 (“the Order”).

The council, pursuant to the Bournemouth, Christchurch and Poole Council (Reorganisation of Community Governance) (Bournemouth) Order 2025, and the recommendations dated 9 December 2025, makes the following Supplementary Order in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 86, 98(3), 98(4) and 240(10) of the 2007 Act.

Citation and commencement

1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Bournemouth, Christchurch and Poole Council (Reorganisation of Community Governance) (Bournemouth) (Supplementary) Order 2026.

(2) It shall come into force on 1 April 2026.

Interpretation

2. In this Order—

“district” means the district of Bournemouth, Christchurch and Poole.

Effect of Order

3. This Order has effect subject to any agreement under section 99 (agreements about incidental matters) of the Local Government and Public Involvement in Health Act 2007 relevant to any provision of this Order.

Transfer of property, rights and liabilities

4.—(1) Article 11(b) of the Bournemouth, Christchurch and Poole Council (Reorganisation of Community Governance) (Bournemouth) Order 2025 Order shall be varied so as to read:

“detailing the land, property, rights and liabilities which shall transfer from the Bournemouth Charter Trustees to the Bournemouth Town Council and specifying the date of transfer.”

and Article 4(3) of this Order shall give effect to Article 11(b) as so amended.

(2) The land, property, rights and liabilities described in Schedule 1 shall transfer from the Bournemouth, Christchurch and Poole Council to the Bournemouth Town Council on the date specified in column 2 of that Schedule.

(3) The land, property, rights and liabilities described in Schedules 2 and 3 shall transfer from The Charter Trustees for Bournemouth to the Bournemouth Town Council on the date specified in column 2 of those Schedules.

Order date

7. 1st April 2026 is the order date for the purposes of the Local Government (Parishes and Parish Councils) (England) Regulations 2008.

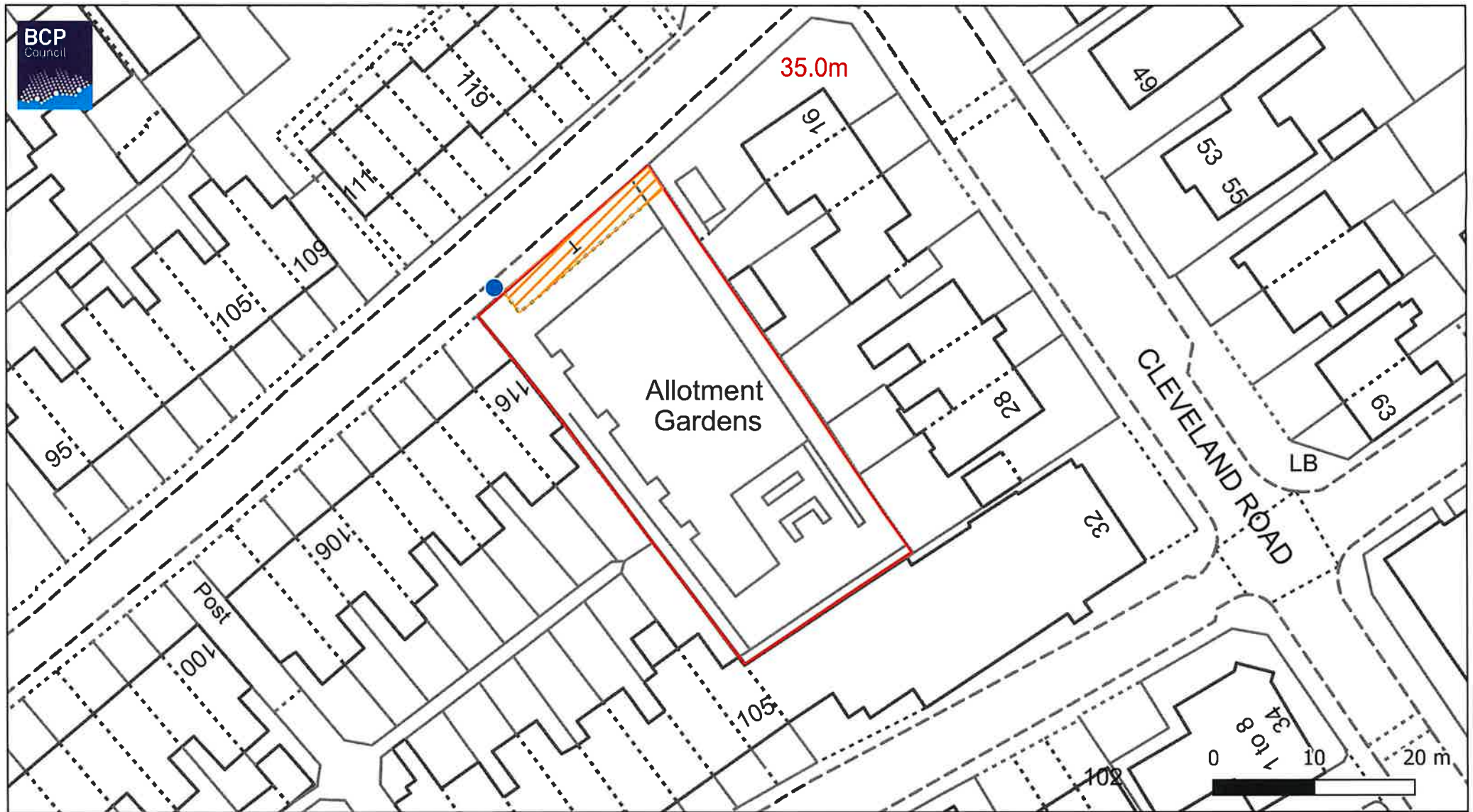

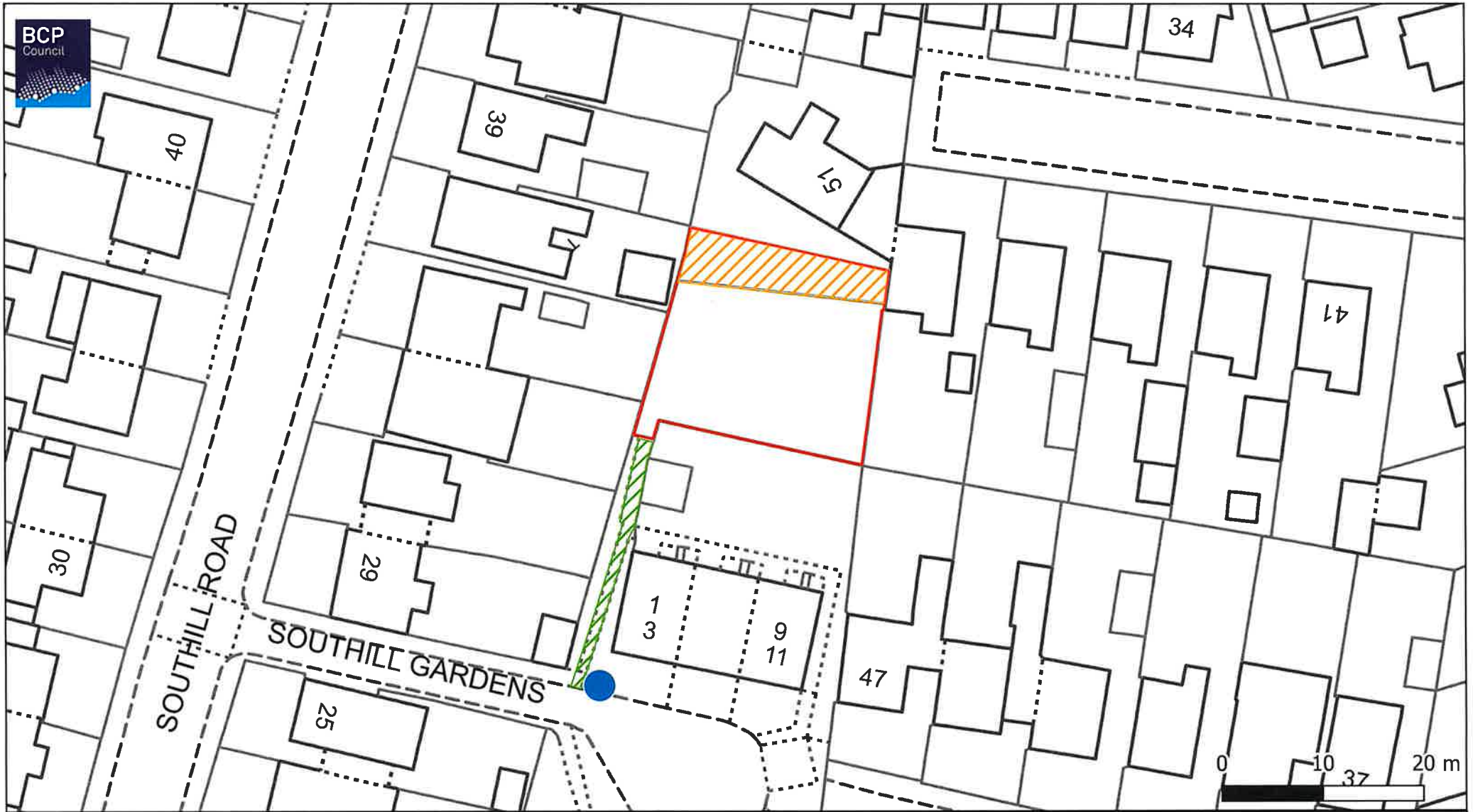

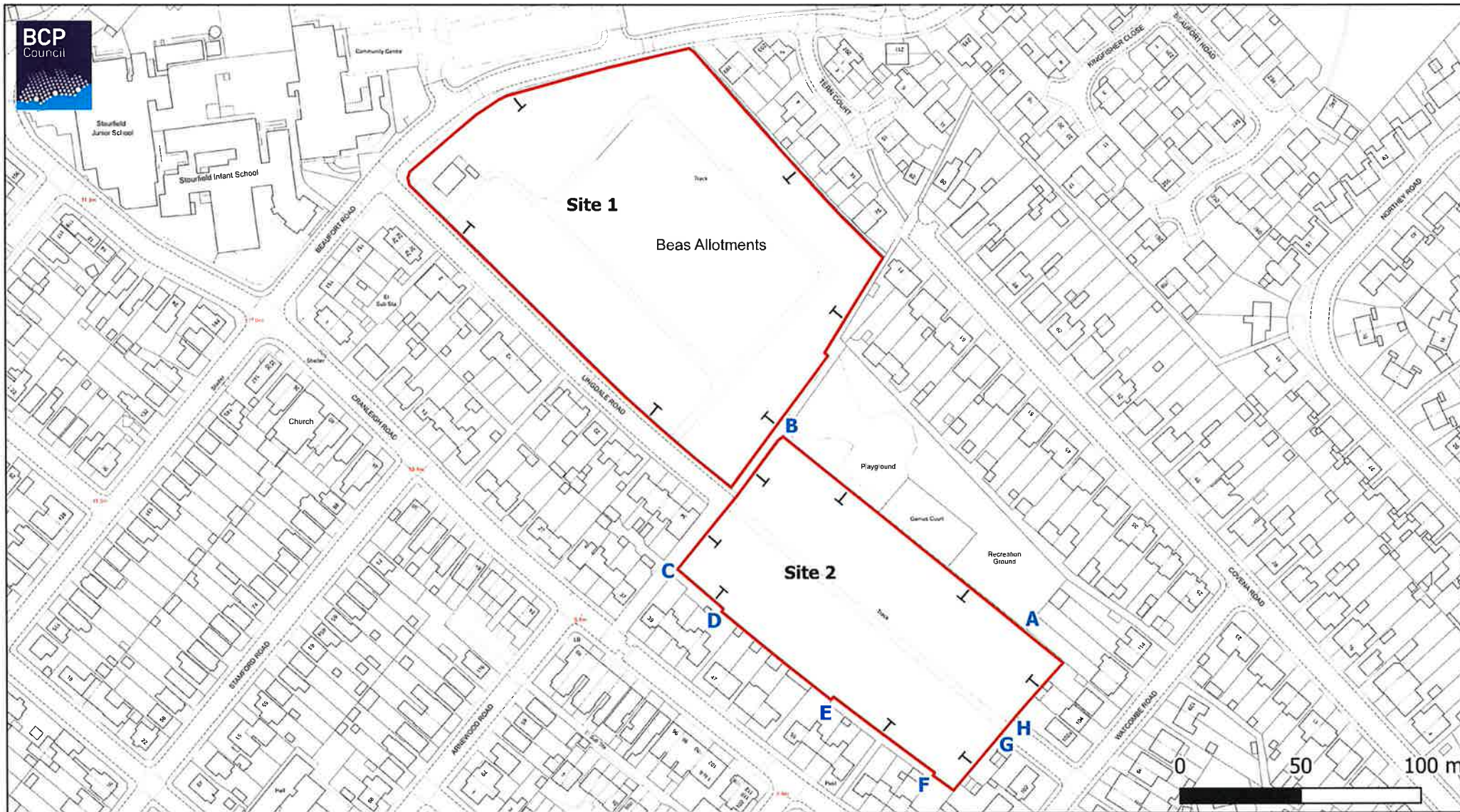

Inward T Site 2 – Town Council's boundary responsibilities between points A-B, B-C, C-D, E-F and G-H.

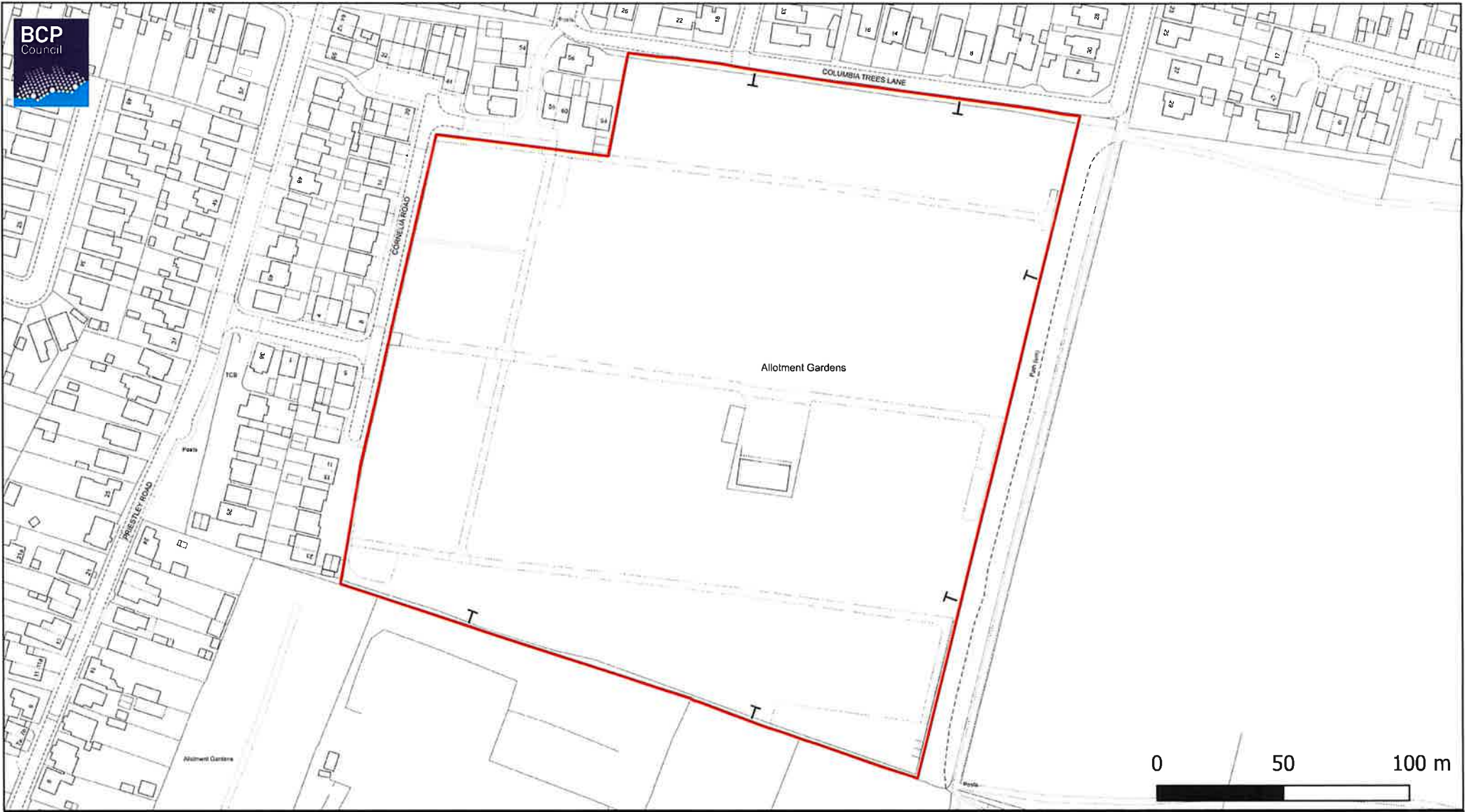

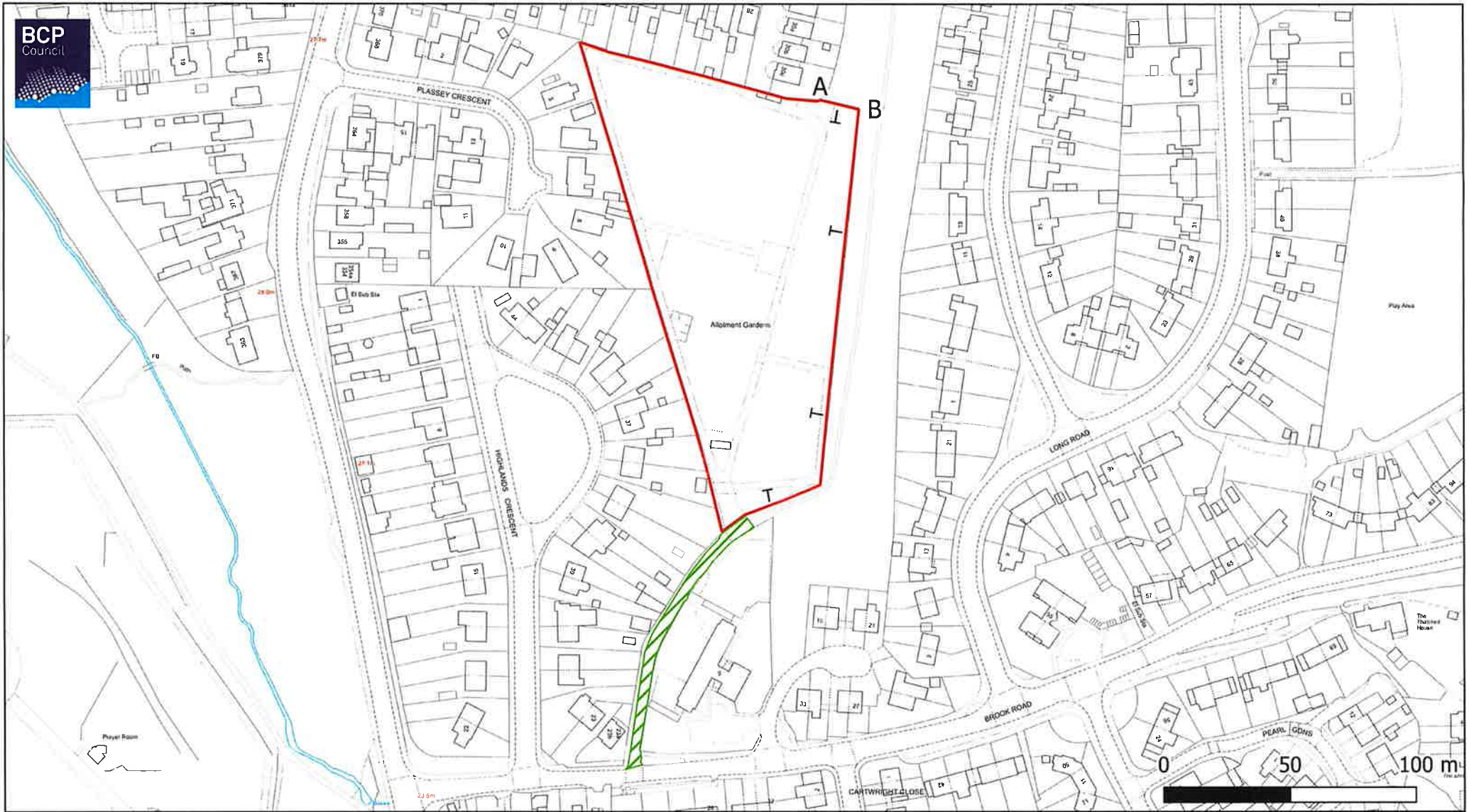

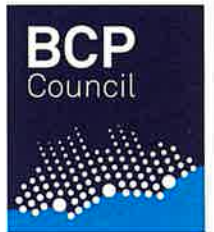
