As a Bournemouth Central Ward Councillor, I have concerns that granting this application could undermine the licensing objectives, particularly the prevention of crime and disorder, the prevention of public nuisance, and the protection of vulnerable people within Bournemouth town centre.

The town centre already experiences significant issues associated with alcohol-related anti-social behaviour, street drinking, and public nuisance. I am concerned that the introduction of an additional off-sales alcohol licence at this location has the potential to exacerbate these existing problems and place further pressure on local residents, businesses, and enforcement agencies.

I would also like to request the opportunity to address the Licensing Sub-Committee when this application is heard. Please confirm that my representation has been accepted and advise me of the hearing date, the arrangements for speaking, and any further information you require from me.
