Following advice given – You mention in several emails the issue of the Sex Establishment Policy. After referring to our legal advisor I can advise that BCP Council's position that there is currently no Sex Establishment Policy is based on the High Court's decision in <i>R (CDE) v BCP Council</i> [2023] EWHC 194 (Admin), which quashed the 2021 policy. Once quashed, the policy is treated as void and of no legal effect. The previous policies of Bournemouth and Poole Councils were expressly replaced and do not revive upon the quashing of the new policy. This is consistent with established administrative law principles and case law. Licensing decisions are now made under the statutory provisions of the Local Government (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1982, without a current policy
