Customer Code of Conduct

- Customers must be seated before a dancer can commence a dance, and must remain seated during the dance with their hands at their sides.
- There must be no touching of the dancers at any time during the dance, except when paying the dance fee.
- Dancers are not allowed to touch Customers at any time during the dance, except when accepting payment for the dance.
- No propositioning the dancers.
- Customers must not dance at any time.
- The customer must remain fully clothed at all times and not indulge in sexual behaviour.
- Customers should be polite and not harass or intimidate the dancers.
- Any breach of the above rules will result in the customer being excluded from the club.

Table Dance Rules

- As an industry standard we recommend a topless dance at £10 and a private nude dance at £20.
- The industry standard is that one dance is the equivalent of one song track. This may on occasion change due to special promotions.
- The price of a dance should be agreed with the dancer before the dance.

DANCER CODE OF CONDUCT**

DANCERS' CODE OF CONDUCT

1. Dancers may not intentionally touch a customer during a performance.
2. Dancers may not permit a customer to touch them during a performance.
3. Dancers may not straddle the customer.
4. If a customer attempts to touch or speak to a dancer inappropriately, the dancer shall stop the performance and advise the customer of the rules of the Code of Conduct. If the customer persists in inappropriate behaviour, the dancer shall stop the performance and inform premises management immediately.
5. Dancers may not intentionally touch the genitals, anus or breasts of another dancer, nor knowingly permit another dancer to touch their genitals, anus or breasts.
6. Dancers shall not solicit for gratuities or payment for sexual favours.
7. Dancers shall not engage in any act of prostitution, i.e. the receiving of gratuities or payment for sexual favours.
8. Dancers may not perform any act which simulates masturbation, oral sex or sexual intercourse, including the insertion of any object, including their own finger, in to the anus or vagina.
9. Dancers may not touch their own breasts, anus or genitals with their fingers, lips or tongue.
10. Dancers may not be in the company of a customer unless it is in an area of the premises that is open to the public.
11. Dancers shall not perform if under the influence of alcohol or drugs.
12. If a customer engages in acts of masturbation or other sexual behaviour, the dancer shall cease the performance immediately and inform the premises management.

13. Dancers shall use the dressing room facilities provided for their exclusive use to change for their performance.
14. Dancers shall only use the smoking area provided specifically for their use.
15. Dancers are not allowed to take customers contact details, nor are they permitted to give their own contact details out to customers.

CLUB TEMPTATION WELFARE POLICY

1. All prospective dancers/applicants, before they are permitted to perform, are met with by the Manager/ dancer supervisor (house mother) who speaks to them.
2. Identity and age checks are made and copies of documentation to establish the individual's right to work in the UK is required before any dancer is permitted to perform at the premises. The manager will give the individual a copy of the Dancers code of conduct and the SEV licence conditions. They are required to confirm that they have read and understood the code and the conditions. Also, there are regular entertainer and security meetings at which the security and dancers are reminded of the requirements.
3. Security and staff are reminded that if they see a breach of the code or the licence then the issue is to be brought to the attention of the manager. This usually involves the individual being taken to the manager where the allegation is repeated and a written record is kept. The dancer is given an opportunity to respond and appropriate disciplinary action if any is taken.
4. We have a customer code of conduct and a dancer code of conduct and if there are any difficulties or breaches these will be dealt with by the local manager.
5. All parts of the club are covered by CCTV which records at all times the premises are open.
6. Security staff are on duty at all times the premises are open to the public. The door supervisors are positioned around the venue and also patrol the performance areas to ensure compliance with the codes of conduct in place and the safety of the performers. Customers who do not comply with the code are spoken to and warned and where appropriate will be removed from the venue.
7. Contact details of support groups are available for dancers that struggle with drink and alcohol abuse for help and guidance.
